### DECISIONS

- ***Bell v Civil Air Search and Rescue Association et al*, [2018 MBCA 96](#)**  
Appeal from judicial review – individual successfully reviewed association’s decision to suspend membership – Did court have jurisdiction to review membership decision in private organization? – court does not have jurisdiction – state decision making must be at issue – procedural fairness not reviewed in voluntary association except where property or civil right at issue – not at issue – appeal allowed
- ***BBA Aviation, PLC v. BBA Remanufacturing Inc.*, [2018 COMC 94](#)**  
BBA aviation requested expunging of BBA Remanufacturing trademark – BBA Remanufacturing not involved in aerospace industry – trademark was not used in connection with the services it is registered for – violation of statute – trademark expunged from register

PSAC and employer applied for amendment to union certificate – amendment granted – certificate now reads: “*all employees of the Edmonton Regional Airport Authority, excluding Fire Fighters, Fire Lieutenants, Fire Captains, Human Resources Coordinators, Human Resources Business Partners, Paralegals, Legal Counsel, Senior Communications Advisors, Safety Superintendents, Executive Assistants, students, and those employed as managers and above.*”
